## Gina Villalobos, Rock 'n' Roll Pony

Gina Villalobos' Rock 'n' Roll Pony will remind you what a great rock album is supposed to sound like. It's not exactly new and daring, but it does have a real electricity and honesty that will open some eyes to this emerging Los Angeles, California-based talent. A skillful amalgam of indie rock, country, and power pop, Rock 'n' Roll Pony defies easy classification while still sounding familiar. Great tracks like "Why," "I'm Alright," and "Put the Message in a Box" (a World Party cover) will remind you as much of Matthew Sweet as country-rock angels like Lucinda Williams or Sheryl Crow. Villalobos' sweet but gritty vocals are a perfect complement to her provocative, self-deprecating lyrics ("I think I need an operation / Come on and cut me up") and her band's big, crunchy southern California sound.
